Library and Arts Development: This service provides a varied program of arts and cultural activities. Council plans and develops arts and cultural infrastructure and develops policies and strategies to facilitate art practice. The function is also responsible for the provision of library services at Torquay and across the municipality with a mobile service and makes provision for a Budget of \$39,000 Operation Project for a Pop-Up Art Space (location unclear).

The 2018/2019 Draft Budget clearly illustrates that Council has not yet started to budget for any arts facilities expenditure anywhere in the Shire particularly in the Torquay Ward which represents about 50% of the Shire population and in which further rapid growth is forecast.

8. Torquay Theatre Troupe History/Statistics

Torquay Theatre Troupe has been active since 2001 (17 years) and was registered with Consumer Affairs Victoria (Number A0049798B) as an incorporated not-for-profit organisation 13th July 2007.

In its early days TTT operated out of private homes and Shire community halls and over the last decade has performed principally at the Senior Citizens Centre in Price Street, Torquay.

The Troupe provides the Torquay community with 2 full-scale productions per annum and a One-Act performance which is usually performed in various venues in the shire and which is entered in the annual Anglesea One Act Play Festival. Each production is run for 7 (sometimes 10) performances to an overall audience of between 560 and 640. Performances and audience are constrained by facility space because of the seating and some set having to be struck daily to allow other daytime users access to the Senior Citizens Hall between TTT production nights.

TTT records show that since its inception in 2001 the organisation has staged over 45 Scripts (see page 8) in 11 venues (80% in Torquay) across the Bellarine Peninsula involving 331 actors presenting over 330 evenings of entertainment for Torquay, Surf Coast and Bellarine audience. This is in line with Geelong -Bellarine performance statistics⁶. Torquay Theatre Troupe has a current subscriber list over 415. A core group of c.30 individuals have a wide range of collective skills in many aspects of Theatre. TTT productions have received nine (9) Victorian Drama League (VDL) nominations (2015 & 2017) and one VDL Award (2015) and a more than 35 Nominations from Geelong/ Regional organisations⁷ resulting in six (6) Awards (2003, 2004, 2006, 2014, 2016 and 2017)

⁶ Geelong has 33 theatre and performance companies, of which around 25 are working at any given time. Our region stages around 60 non-professional productions every year, ranging from small plays in temperance halls to big shows in the Playhouse and Costa. We entertain between 18 and 30,000 people in a year and in total turnover somewhere between \$2 and \$3 million. It's estimated that this figure could be doubled, when you take into consideration the ancillary earnings - when people come to see our productions, they will buy dinner out, coffees, overnight accommodation. We spill over into tourism, as those involved in our enactment tours of Geelong's cemeteries will know. So, we really are significant players in our region's economy. We just don't appreciate it because we're usually only worrying about staging and getting an audience for one show at a time.
